



The Rev. Dr. Chloe Breyer

Executive Director, The Interfaith Center of New York

Since 2007, the Rev. Dr. Chloe Breyer has directed The Interfaith Center of New York, a nationally-recognized nonprofit that works with hundreds of grassroots religious leaders from twelve faith traditions to catalyze partnerships with civic officials to resolve social problems plaguing New York City. Issues include police reform, immigration concerns, and domestic violence. Institutional partners have included the New York Unified Court System, Catholic Charities, UJA Federation, & the National Endowment for the Humanities. Programs include *Re-entry Circles of Support* (2011-), *Catholic Muslim Service Partnerships* (2010--), and the *Rabbi Marshall Meyer Social Justice Retreats* (1998--). In addition to program work, ICNY advocates for religious freedom and civil rights. An Episcopal Priest in the Diocese of New York, Breyer also serves as Associate priest at St. Philip's Church in Harlem. Her Doctoral Dissertation in Christian Ethics at Union Theological Seminary is on Interfaith activism, Christian peacemaking, and Islamophobia.
